

**ART. 111 - ENTRY FOR FOREIGN-TRAINED HORSES**

*“In order for a foreign-trained horse to be entered in a public race in France for the first time, the horse must be duly declared by the trainer on the France Galop website **at least 15 days prior to the day of the race** in which the horse is due to take part.*

*This declaration must include its full designation including name, sex, year of foaling, coat, breeding (sire, dam, dam's sire) and the suffix of the country of birth.*

*Furthermore, if the race takes place more than 15 days after the entry closing, the declaration above must be made no later than the day before the general entry closing day.*

***If an entry is not registered due to a non-compliance with this provision, no appeal may be lodged.”***
